Asbestos Disposal

Asbestos is a hazardous material and is heavily regulated, by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP). Due to the nature of the material all asbestos disposal must be pre-approved and scheduled by Jeff Howley, Environmental Specialist, prior to disposal. By pre-approving and scheduling the loads, we can guarantee that the proper documentation and procedures are followed.

All customers must have the proper documentation before disposing of their asbestos material. This documentation includes:

1. Copy of the permit issued by the Building Department.
2. Drivers License or other photo id.
3. A \$25.00 asbestos disposal permit.
4. If material is coming from a commercial building, or residential facility of 3 or more units, a copy of a form from the Department of Environmental Protection must be included.
5. An asbestos manifest.

If material is to be accepted, the customer will be given a date and an estimated time to arrive for disposal. All asbestos material should be wetted, and must be double bagged and labeled. All forms are to accompany the load. The rate for disposal is a fee of \$75.00 per visit, and the current tonnage rate.
